Health kits for Haiti— UMCOR is requesting the following new items to make health kits for Haiti. The items should be placed in a sealed one-gallon plastic bag: 1 hand towel (15” x 25” up to 17” x 27”. No kitchen towels, 1 washcloth, 1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized), 1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers), 1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up), 1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, no child-size brushes), 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages, \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste. (NOTE: Toothpaste is purchased in bulk to be added to health kits to ensure that the product does not expire before they are sent.) *Please do not include anything that is not on the list. It will be removed before it can be sent.*
